## PRELIMINARY SUMMARY OF CHANGES IN BIRD DISTRIBUTIONS BETWEEN THE FIRST AND SECOND SOUTHERN AFRICAN BIRD ATLAS PROJECTS (SABAP1 AND SABAP2)



The First and Second Southern African Bird Atlas Projects took place two decades apart (Fig. 1). The first Southern African Bird Atlas Project (SABAP1 1987–1991; Harrison 1992; Harrison *et al.* 1997, 2008) and the second Southern African Bird Atlas Project (SABAP2: July 2007–ongoing) provide an opportunity to study how the ranges of species have changed (Harebottle *et al.* 2007; Loftie-Eaton 2014). This paper demonstrates how large these changes have been.

SABAP1 used quarter degree grid cells (QDGC) as the spatial sampling unit. These cover 15 minutes of latitude by 15 minutes of longitude ( $15' \times 15'$ ) and correspond to the standard 1:50 000 topographical maps used within southern Africa (Harebottle *et al.* 2007). The SABAP2 spatial sampling unit is the “pentad” which covers 5 minutes of latitude by 5 minutes of longitude ( $5' \times 5'$ ), about 8.0 km $\times$ 7.6 km. There are nine pentads per QDGC. The pentads are nested within QDGC, and data for each pentad can be combined into QDGC format, which can then be compared with SABAP1 data to detect any large-scale

changes in bird distribution. SABAP2 was initially confined to South Africa, Lesotho and Swaziland (Harebottle *et al.* 2007), and this limitation constrains this analysis of range changes to these three countries.

Making comparisons between SABAP1 and SABAP2 is more complex than anticipated at the start of SABAP2 (Loftie-Eaton 2014). The difficulties relate mainly to the change in scale from the QDGC for SABAP1 to the pentad for SABAP2. This analysis follows the precedent of lumping the data for the nine pentads within a QDGC together, and treating them as equivalent to the lists from SABAP1 for the QDGC. This was done for example by Altweig *et al.* (2013), Hofmeyr *et al.* (2014) and Loftie-Eaton (2014). Problems with this approach




Fig 2 - Graphical representation of the 50 worst performing species in Table 2. Red is associated with Major declines, Orange with Moderate declines, Yellow with Minor declines, Light Green with Minor increases, Dark Green with Moderate increases and Blue with Major increases.



have been highlighted by case studies comparing SABAP1 and SABAP2 results for a single QDGC (McKenzie 2011; de Swardt 2012, 2014; Carter 2012; Retief 2014) and discussed and reviewed in considerable detail by Loftie-Eaton (2014).

Our fundamental unit of comparison is the reporting rates, the proportion of checklists which reported the species in a particular grid cell, in each of the atlas projects. Caveats to the interpretation of reporting rates were discussed in detail by Harrison and Underhill (1997); nevertheless there is overwhelming evidence that reporting rates are monotonically related to abundance, but non-linearly (eg Harrison and Navarro 1994; Griffioen 2001). For one species in one QDGC, the change in reporting rates between SABAP1 and SABAP2 is likely to be due to changes in abundance. The standard test statistic for the equality of two proportions (Underhill and Bradfield 1996) was used as index to measure change:

$$Z = \frac{P_2 - P_1}{\sqrt{P(1-P)(\frac{1}{n_1} + \frac{1}{n_2})}}$$

where  $P_1$  and  $P_2$  are the reporting rates from SABAP1 and SABAP2 respectively,  $n_1$  and  $n_2$  are the numbers of checklists on which the reporting rates are based, and  $P$ , the pooled reporting rate, is given by

$$P = \frac{n_1 P_1 + n_2 P_2}{n_1 + n_2}$$

This approach was also used by Hofmeyr *et al.* (2014). The analysis was confined to the 1440 quarter degree grid cells for which there were four or more checklists for both SABAP1 and SABAP2 on 9 June 2014. This is 72% of the 2002 QDGCs in South Africa, Lesotho and Swaziland. We calculated the Z-score for each species for those of the 1440 QDGCs where it had occurred either in SABAP1 or SABAP2. For each species, we classified the Z-scores into six verbal categories using conventional values from the standard normal distribution as the cutpoints: major decrease ( $Z < -1.96$ ), moderate decrease ( $-1.96 < Z < -1.04$ ), minor decrease ( $-1.04 < Z < 0$ ), minor increase ( $0 < Z < 1.04$ ), moderate increase ( $1.04 < Z < 1.96$ ), and major increase ( $Z > 1.96$ ). As done by Hofmeyr *et al.* (2014), we do not associate formal significance levels with these cutpoints; we intend that these be used as providing useful insights into the overall patterns of change for each species. The values 1.04 and 1.96 are the 15% and 2.5% points of the normal distribution.

The results are meaningless for species that have been subject to splits since SABAP1, and these species were excluded. The key issue that the data collection was done for SABAP1 using the species recognized at the time; it is not possible, with integrity, to allocate these records into split species. We also restricted the analysis to species which had been recorded in at least 50 of the 1440 QDGCs across both SABAP1 and SABAP2.




Fig 3 - Graphical representation of the 50 best performing species in Table 3. Colours are coded as in Figure 2.



This yielded a total of 574 species (Table 1). In Table 1, the six categories, from major decrease to major increase, are headed <<<, <<, <, >, >> and >>>, respectively.

In Table 2, the 125 species with the largest proportional decreases (<<<) in Table 1 are listed in order of the magnitude of the decrease. Table 3, likewise, shows the 125 species with the largest proportional increases. Occurrence of a species in both Tables 2 and 3 would be suggestive of a range shift for the species, if the area of increase was contiguous and the area of decrease was likewise contiguous. Only one species occurs in both Tables 2 and 3. This is the African Black Oystercatcher *Haematopus moquini*. Inspection of the "range-change" map tends to suggest that the species has declined on the West Coast of South Africa, and increased in abundance on the coastline of the Eastern Cape and KwaZulu-Natal.

The purpose of this paper is to present these results. In depth discussion of them will largely need to be dealt with on a species-by-species basis. This process has already been initiated for the Secretarybird *Sagittarius serpentarius* (Hofmeyr *et al.* 2014).
